HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT ATTENDS THE INAUGURAL SESSION OF BOTSWANA AND ZIMBABWE BI-NATIONAL COMMISSION: 27 - 28 FEBRUARY 2019

GABORONE 25th February 2019: The Ministry of International Affairs and Cooperation wishes to inform that His Excellency Dr. Mokgweetsi Eric Keabetswe Masisi, President of the Republic of Botswana, will travel to Harare, Zimbabwe on 27th to 28th February 2019, to attend the Inaugural Session of Botswana and Zimbabwe Bi-National Commission (BNC).

The BNC is a high level platform that replaced the Joint Permanent Commission on Cooperation and the Joint Permanent Commission on Defence and Security between the two countries, through the Agreement signed on the margins of the 38th SADC Summit held in Namibia in August 2018. The Inaugural Bi-National Commission is therefore expected to exchange views on bilateral and international issues of mutual interest. The BNC will further discuss the state of bilateral cooperation in areas such as Trade and Investment, Agriculture, Tourism, Energy as well as, Defence and Security.

The Heads of State Meeting (BNC) will be preceded by the Officials Meeting, and the Ministerial Meeting of the Bi-National Commission from 25th to 26th and 27th February 2019, respectively.

His Excellency the President will be accompanied by the Minister of International Affairs and Cooperation, Hon. Dr. Unity Dow; the Minister of Defence, Justice and Security, Hon. Shaw Kgathi; the Minister of Agricultural Development and Food Security, Hon. Patrick Ralotsia; the Minister of Land Management, Water and Sanitation Services, Hon.
