The Advisory Committee is mandated with the critical responsibility of facilitating appointment of the highest caliber of qualifying judges to the ICC. The Committee comprises of nine (9) States Parties members who are appointed based on the various global legal systems, gender balance, equitable geographic representation and candidates' competence and experience in criminal or international law.
